## Day 5 – Edfu → Luxor | Nile Cruise

## Terms & Conditions

All bookings with Plan & Pack are confirmed only after the payment of an advance deposit, and by confirming a booking you agree to these Terms & Conditions. Bookings remain subject to availability at the time of confirmation. A non-refundable deposit of 30% of the package cost is required (50% for Almaty and select international packages), with the balance payable 30 days before departure—or 7 days prior in the case of certain international tours. Payments are accepted only through official Plan & Pack accounts, and quotes are valid for 6 working days from the date of issue, after which prices may vary due to exchange rates or availability. Package costs are based on prevailing airfares, hotel rates, and currency values; prices may change due to fluctuations, taxes, fuel surcharges, or supplier revisions, but once full payment is made the rate is locked.

Each package clearly specifies what is included, such as transfers, accommodation, breakfast, and certain entry tickets. Exclusions typically cover visas, flights, insurance, porter services, personal expenses, optional activities, and any services not explicitly mentioned in the inclusions. Travel insurance is strongly recommended for all international tours. Cancellation policies apply as follows: cancellations made more than 30 days before departure are eligible for a refund excluding the deposit and charges; 15–30 days before departure incur a 50% charge; within 14 days of departure, no refund is provided (though future travel credit may be considered case by case). A no-show will result in 100% cancellation charges. Visa rejection or delays will also be treated as cancellations.

Travelers are solely responsible for valid passports, visas, and documentation. Plan & Pack may assist with visa processing at additional cost, but final approval lies solely with the embassy. Failure to secure documents will be treated as cancellation. Requests for changes to names, dates, or services are subject to availability, additional charges, and airline/hotel policies, which may treat them as cancellations. Any such requests must be submitted in writing.

Plan & Pack is not liable for delays, cancellations, lost documents, natural calamities, political unrest, accidents, theft, sickness, or force majeure events.
